Presbyterian Women (PW) is the national women's organization of the Presbyterian Church (USA). With more than 300,000 members and 25 years as an organization, PW is organized at all levels of the Presbyterian Church (USA).



For more than 200 years Presbyterian women's groups have strengthened the Presbyterian Church and played a major role in sharing the good news of Jesus Christ and witnessing to the promise of God's kingdom. The women of our church are part of the proud tradition. The Women's Organization of First Presbyterian Church honor the special occasions of our lives with wedding and baby showers, and by placing roses on the communion table when a baby is born. The Women remember our shut-ins at Christmas time with a visit, a Christmas gift, and a poinsettia. They also provide food for families of loved ones at funerals.

The Rummage Room is a function of the Women's Organization. Funds are raised by regular sales that go toward the many projects supported by the Women. But if a family in our community suffers a crisis, such as a house fire, the doors are opened for them to take what they need at no cost.

All women of the church are automatically members, so signing up is not required. All women of First Presbyterian Church of Rockwood are encouraged to participate in any or all of the Women's activities. And all the men of our church are encouraged to encourage the women!
